Policy Statement

The City of Lexington is committed to the quality of life for all residents, therefore, Lexington Parks and Recreation prohibits the use of all forms of tobacco products, including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, pipes, water-pipes, electronic cigarettes, vaping and smokeless tobacco products at city-owned and operated ballfields. This includes: ballfields, dugouts, bleachers, spectator areas, concession areas and restrooms. Appropriate signs will be posted at specified ballfield locations.
